From the school nurse: Beginning of Year Reminders

Hello and welcome to the 2022-2023 school year! We are excited to have your students back in class and we look forward to working with them. In order to help ensure we have the most up to date information for those students with health conditions, please remember to fill out an updated health condition plan which can be found here. Please return these to your student's school office once completed. Any medication



that will be kept at school must have a new <u>medication administration form</u> completed each school year. Please note that there is no longer a separate form for medications that students self carry. All medications must come in their original packaging or pharmacy bottle with the student's name and dosing information. You may find additional information about the Appleton Area School District's policy on medications in the school setting <u>here</u>. Lastly, per Wisconsin law, students are required to be fully immunized or have a signed <u>waiver</u> on file. There are additional immunization requirements for incoming Kindergarten and grade 6 students. If your child has not yet received the appropriate immunizations, please schedule an appointment with your health care provider or the City of Appleton Health Department/Outagamie County Health Department.
