# ELEMENTARY BAND FAQs...

#### **BAND OR STRINGS?**

BOTH! Your student does not have to choose between strings and band in elementary school--a motivated student can do well in both classes!

#### TIME COMMITMENT?

Band is meant to be an enjoyable, fulfilling experience with lots of learning and fun. 15-20 minutes of practice most days of the week will ensure that your student is able to reap all of the benefits of band participation.

#### **EXPENSE?**

Most families choose to rent an instrument at first. Rental costs range from \$30 to \$75 per month depending on the instrument selected. Large instruments such as tuba and baritone are rented through AASD. The district also maintains an inventory of other instruments for students with a financial need. NO ONE is turned away from band because of family finances!
